High Street Parking Sign

Motion

Planting in the Rotunda

Recommendation

The HP&D Committee to approve £2,021 for Town Improvement, Street Scene Working Group to progress with IDVerde the weeding and purchasing or 'life long, low maintenance' plants to improve the rotunda. The Town Improvement, Street Scene Working Group would like to be consulted on a list of plants available and be allowed to choose what is planted.

The committee were asked to review an email from Cllr Sutton and Cllr Kimmins regarding the lack of road signs to the Medical Centre, particularly for those patients attending Minor Operations. The committee requested that Wiltshire Council are contacted and reminded that in the original plan's signs directing people to the White Horse Health Centre should have been added to the existing road signs.

The committee were asked to review and consider if they would like to submit a project for the above programme. The committee first agreed to this November 2017, however the support required from Wiltshire Wildlife and the Forestry Commission never followed through and Westbury Town Council did not have enough information to complete the paperwork and submit a project alone. If the committee wish to follow this up, completed information is required by Friday 30th November 2018. Cllr Cunningham updated the group that he had a conversation with the Community Engagement Officer, Wiltshire Wildlife Trust and they may be interested in following this up. As no update had been received, the committee asked that this was followed up again with the Community Engagement Officer. The committee also requested that if Westbury Town Council are required to submit another location, then the Biss Corridor should be submitted.
