P.3231 REPORT BY WILTSHIRE COUNCILLORS:

Cllr Hawker advised that the report prepared by Mott McDonald on car parking issues would be presented to Cabinet tomorrow and will be debated at Full Council on November 8th 2011. Both Cllrs Hawker and Jenkins agreed that the report was "rubbish" and basically recommended no change to the current system.

Wiltshire Council has failed to respond to WTC's request for information on car parking figures and income. This information is required by the Car Parks Working Group.

Cllr Jenkins attended a meeting in Salisbury regarding a proposal to introduce "Redemption Parking". Any agreement would have to be unanimous which it would not be in Westbury.

P.3232 CHAIRMAN'S COMMUNICATIONS:

Cllr Braid informed that planning application 11/02287/FUL (proposed new dwelling on land south of 25 The Ham Westbury) considered at HP&D 19/09/11. was in fact within Westbury parish, not Heywood as stated at the meeting. As a decision was required by the planning officer, he, together with Cllr Hawker, agreed to object to this planning application on the grounds that the land was outside the town policy limit.
